

Internship Application

Requirements: You must be at least 18 years old to apply. Preferential approval will be given to bilingual (Spanish) applicants. A \$100 deposit must be submitted with your application for the process to begin. You must have a current passport that will not expire prior to the end of your internship. Your completed application must be received at minimum of three (3) months prior to your departure date.

Well, this is exciting (and a little bit unnerving too, we know)! To be obedient to GOD's call on our lives is always a step just outside our comfort zone. Now you have paperwork to fill out, money to raise, airline tickets to buy, people to talk to, what bug spray do I buy, doctor's appointments, donations to manage, packing to do, plans to make, preparations....

WHOA!

Take a deep breath. In this first stage of this new season of life, Satan will try his best to overwhelm you. Knowing that, GOD has placed the devoted, experienced and compassionate staff of SCORE International into your path to help. First things first.

What Does It Mean to Be a SCORE Intern:

Regardless of where you are headed, be it the Dominican Republic, Honduras, Panama, Costa Rica or right here at home, our goal is the same. Our program is designed to not only impact the ministries and the people we serve, but your life as well. The mission is to use this partnership with you [through your unique calling and skill set] to reach the lost, train up disciples and further the Kingdom work being done by full time missionaries on the field.

To quote Eric Champion, our Intern director in Costa Rica, "SCORE interns learn by doing". You are going to be the hands and feet of GOD's plan. Some days that may mean washing team uniforms. Some days that may mean comforting an overwhelmed Short-Term Team member on their first trip away from home. Some days that may mean a quiet prayer over a missionary in a tough situation. Whatever the task, you can be confident that each day will be a chance to grow closer to GOD, strengthen your faith, see GOD in a new way and to humbly serve alongside those in full time ministry.

The process itself goes like this:

1. You complete the intern application and forward it along with your \$100 deposit, as instructed;
2. Your pastor completes his evaluation and forwards that to SCORE;
3. You schedule an appointment with your doctor for a physical evaluation (form provided) and then submit the completed form as instructed;
4. Once all paperwork is in, you'll be scheduled for a telephone interview with the Director of Enlistment and Leadership, Chris Gaither;
5. If confirmed, you'll be approved to begin fundraising and preparing for your trip;
6. There will be a pre-trip orientation weekend retreat, where you'll become acquainted with other interns preparing to "GO", hear about the ministries of SCORE and learn much more about what you can expect on the field;
7. Depending on where you'll be serving and in what ministry, there may be follow up calls or handbooks that you receive directly from them to cover more specific information; and then...
8. You "GO".

Whether GOD is calling you to simply make this next step, or you feel His calling to full time missionary life, one of the beautiful measures of faith is that we must trust in GOD's long-term plans for our lives. With Him, we are never left alone or abandoned. GOD is always faithful to complete the good work He begins. Part of that faithfulness is to provide mentors, leaders, and wise counsel along our walk. That is the calling of SCORE. We seek to make it our priority to provide you with tested and true leadership, to help you in each step of this process and remain connected to you as your return home from the field for transitional guidance, as you process through your experience and for whatever that next step He reveals may be.

Some Things You Can Expect:

If there were a word that captured the essence of internship, it would have to be FLEXIBLE. New challenges and new rewards, new failures and new opportunities to learn and grow, will be plentiful. The structure of the program has been carefully created to give you a solid foundation to build this experience on. Let's talk about what you can expect from SCORE during your internship:

Accountability In Service

You will be assigned to report to a specific person in the field. That may be a Field Director, an Intern Director or even a specific Missionary. Regardless of their title, they will be an important part of your time as an intern. They will serve as your "go to" person for your daily routine. They will evaluate you as you serve, guiding you in places of growth and instructing you in places of inexperience. It is extremely important that you understand their role as your authority.

If this is not your first time in country, even if this is your tenth trip, you are under their authority as well. You should take care to inquire of them in all matters of service, to ensure that you are up to date on the policies and procedures.

Accountability in Study

You will also have someone who will serve as a spiritual mentor. In some cases, this will be the same person you are accountable to for service. In others, it may be a completely different person. Regardless, your spiritual mentor has prayed for you and has sought GOD's direction in how to best lead you during your time in country. You'll likely face a wide array of emotions as well as unfamiliar circumstances and situations. To be prepared, your spiritual health must be strong. Your mentor will be an invaluable resource as you navigate life as an intern.

Evaluations

Giving you feedback on your internship is a vital part of the program. At a minimum, you will receive an evaluation from a member of the staff where you are serving, prior to the end of your internship. You may be evaluated more often as time and circumstances allow, or if a significant event occurs.

But it works both ways! Shortly after you return home, someone from the home office will contact you to debrief your trip. Your experience as an intern is extremely valuable to us. You will be asked a series of standardized questions, all designed to help us continually improve and enhance the program. This is your opportunity to really speak openly and candidly about the impact the internship had on your life and your heart to serve.

Finances

Your internship fee will be based on several factors. Things like how long you are serving, where you are serving and if you are serving within a specific ministry, all play a role in your final cost. Some things that are included in every intern fee are food, transportation, lodging, SCORE shirts (mandatory for some duties), excursion fees and fees charged by the host country for exit and entrance. Your full fee will be discussed with you during your approval interview. We realize that you'd probably like to have that information right now, but this is an opportunity for you to trust in the Lord's provision for this call on your life.

Pre-Trip Orientation

Last but certainly not least, before you depart, you will be asked to attend a pre-trip orientation retreat. Here you'll meet other interns who will be serving with you and in other countries. You'll have a chance to meet the Director of Enlistment and Leadership, Chris Gaither and perhaps even other Home Office staff members. They will pour into you, sharing about the places you'll be serving, the people you'll be working with, the ministry opportunities you'll have, pitfalls and snares to avoid and even helping you get familiar with the culture and customs. The rules and requirements you must abide by will be discussed in detail, and you'll be given many opportunities to ask questions as well. So as questions come to mind as you go forward, be sure to write them down!

OK, are you ready? Here we go, time to fill out all that data and get this application under way!

INTERNSHIP CHECKLIST

This checklist will help you keep order in your process and ensure that all paperwork is completed. You do not need to turn this form in, it is just for you.

Passport Requirements

If you do not presently have a passport, you'll need to apply for one as soon as possible. Problems and roadblocks can slow down the process, so getting it done early is your best bet. If you already have a passport, make sure it is current and will not expire while you are on your trip. Be sure to check the requirements of the country you are visiting. Some will not allow you to enter if your passport is near expiration, even if it covers your trip entirely.

Third Party Forms

This packet includes two third-party forms, meaning someone else must complete them on your behalf. The Pastor's Reference can simply be given to your current Pastor. The Medical Report will require you scheduling a visit with your doctor for an exam. It must be completed by a licensed physician or physician's assistant.

Submitting Your Application For Consideration

Return your completed application, deposit and all third-party documents to the Home Office. The acceptance process does not begin until your deposit and ALL paperwork is completed and received. You will be contacted by our Leadership and Enlistment Director for your interview. If approved, you will be sent an acceptance letter, an invitation to the next Intern Orientation Weekend Retreat, along with some other pertinent information.

Seeking Donations

Upon receipt of an acceptance letter, which will include access to and explanation of your "Managed Missions Account", you may then begin sending out donation letters. We have included a copy of a sample letter you can use as a template to create your own personalized letter.

- The cost of your trip will be determined on the length of your stay. You will be given a payment schedule with your acceptance letter. The account must be paid in full before your departure date.
- You are responsible for purchasing your AIRLINE TICKETS, secure them early. E-mail Yvonne a copy of the FLIGHT ITINERARY as soon as you receive it.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe that all the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired of God, and they are without error in the original writings, and they are the supreme and final authority for faith and life.
2. We believe in one God, Creator and sustainer of the universe, who is eternally existent in three persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the Deity of Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, sinless life, His death to pay the penalty for our sins, His bodily resurrection, His exaltation at God's right hand, and His personal, imminent, and premillennial return.
4. We believe that all have sinned and are therefore guilty before God and are under His condemnation.
5. We believe that all who by faith receive Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit, therefore children of God and eternally saved, and that the Holy Spirit dwells within every believer to enlighten, guide, and enable the believer in life, testimony, and service. We believe that God answers the prayers of His people and meets their needs according to His purpose.
6. We believe that God gives spiritual gifts to all believers for the building up of the body of Christ and the reaching of the lost. All gifts must be within the guidelines of sacred scripture.
7. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved in Glory and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost in hell.
8. We believe that all believers are called to a life of separation from all worldly and sinful practices and alliances.

STANDARD OF CONDUCT

1. SCORE International, Inc. (including domestic and foreign affiliations under the SCORE International structure) is dedicated to the Lordship of Christ in all areas of life. The distinctives of SCORE International lie in its philosophy and goals. Those who are directly associated with SCORE International, including directors and staff form a community and are not a collection of autonomous individuals. These associates consequently bear certain responsibilities and obligations within the organization for the implementation of its philosophy and goals. In order that the organization functions smoothly and its goals be realized, it is necessary that there be a mutual commitment to a corpus of standards which involve the willing surrender of certain individual purposes and goals.
2. SCORE International, Inc. must follow specific biblical principles, which relate to Christian behavior. Therefore, SCORE International prohibits practices which are clearly forbidden by the Word of God, such as drunkenness, sexual immorality, dishonesty, etc. (1 Cor. 6:9-20). Further, to expect the Christian to exemplify Christian love, consideration for the rights of others, honesty and a high sense of Christian ethics is to expect only that which the Word of God teaches to be primary in the character of the Christian (**Eph 4:24-5**)
3. SCORE International, Inc. is firmly committed to a literal interpretation of the Bible and rejects any attempt to "reinterpret" Scripture in light of "modern" moral or psychological theories. In the Biblical account of creation, the family was the first societal institution ordained by God (**Gen. 1 :27; 2:18-22**). Furthermore, Scripture plainly declares that the first two humans created by God were a man and a woman (**Gen. 1 :27; 2:18-22**). God joined the man and the woman in the holy rite of matrimony and commanded them to be fruitful, multiply, and

replenish the earth (**Gen. 1:28**). Therefore, the only legitimate marriage is the joining of one man and one woman (**Gen. 2:24; Rom. 7:2; 1 Cor. 7:10; Eph. 5:22-23**).

In both the Old and New Testaments, God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity should take place outside of a marriage between a man and a woman. Accordingly, all forms of homosexuality, lesbianism, bisexuality, bestiality, incest, fornication, adultery and pornography are sinful perversions of God's gift of sex. (**Gen. 2:24; 13; 19:5; 26:8-9; Lev. 13:22; 18:1-30; Rom. 1:26-29; 1 Cor. 5:1, 6:9, 1 Thess. 4:1-8; Heb. 13:4**).

Since SCORE International, Inc. believes that all sexual activity outside of a marriage between a man and a woman, including homosexual practices, are in direct opposition to God's Word and constitutes a direct contradiction to God's institution of home, SCORE International, Inc. will not employ or continue to employ men or women who promote or participate in homosexual behavior or any other sexual activity outside of marriage.

4. SCORE International, Inc. recognizes the principles of Christian liberty within the sphere of those things, which are intrinsically innocent. However, SCORE International also recognizes that liberty needs to be restricted in certain instances. Scriptural precedent is found in Acts 15 and Romans 14, where certain practices inherently innocent were forbidden because they could do spiritual harm to other members of the Christian community. Verses for reference include:
 - * I Corinthians 6: 12 — Lawful, but not expedient (not profitable for our good)
 - * I Corinthians 10:23 — Lawful, but not edifying.
 - * I Corinthians 8:9 — Could be a stumbling block.
 - * Romans 1 :32 — Christians are different, and by living like the world, we approve of it. There should be no pleasure in watching sin.
 - * Ephesians 5:6-7, 11 — Don't be deceived with vanity and participate in it.
 - * Colossians 3: 17 — Make sure it pleases the Lord, not the emotions — flesh or self.
 - * Hebrews 12: 1-2 — Lay aside weights as well as the sin.
5. Certain principles of conduct are a necessary part of the effort to establish an atmosphere within which the goals of SCORE International can be realized. For this reason, SCORE International requires associates of the organization to refrain from the possession or use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illicit drugs, from gambling and from the participation in oath-bound secret organizations (societies. Christian discretion and restraint will be exercised in all choices of entertainment, including radio, television, audio and visual recordings, and various forms of literature. Also, Christian discretion will be exercised in observance of the Lord's Day. Furthermore, it is expected that associates will actively support a local Bible-believing church through service, giving, and allegiance.
6. SCORE International, Inc. rejects the principle that exposure to and/or experimentation with doubtful and objectionable practices is essential to the development of moral or intellectual discernment and/or discrimination. SCORE International reserves the right to make the final decision in any questionable area based upon Biblical principles.
7. SCORE International, Inc. recognizes that observance of SCORE International standards does not comprise the whole of an individual's responsibility to God and hence does not necessarily indicate that one is living a life of full commitment. The philosophy of SCORE International, however, maintains that willingness to obey these Biblical standards shows a maturity and spiritual concern for the whole Christian community. (**Gal. 5:13-24**).
8. Conduct that is an offense to good taste, sound morality, or Biblical foundation will not be acceptable. While some may not have personal convictions wholly in accordance with SCORE International standards, the purpose underlying them necessitates the honorable obedience to them. If an individual can no longer in integrity conform to them, that person should withdraw from SCORE International immediately.

9. To insure that the doctrinal position of SCORE International will be maintained in an uncompromising manner and believing that a consistent and exemplary life, according to Biblical standards and principles, should be expected of those who undertake the instruction and guidance of Christian youth, it is required that those associated with the organization shall individually affirm by signing the following at the time of initial association and shall so re-affirm at such time as determined by SCORE International, Inc.

TAX-DEDUCTIBLE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS

Send Personal or Cashier's Checks, or Money Orders. Do not send or give cash to team members. **IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A TAX DEDUCTION**, make all checks or money orders payable to SCORE International and attach the check to a note with the team member's name and trip information (if you received a donation request letter from the team member, there should be a form at the bottom for you to attach to your check). **DO NOT** write the team member's name anywhere on the check. Checks made payable to team members are not tax-deductible.

NOTE ANY DUE DATES OR DEADLINES SO YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS ARE RECEIVED BEFORE THE DUE DATE.

This is very important to the team member. Team members are notified of all contributions received in our office. All funds donated to SCORE International in the U.S. or Canada are not refundable and not transferable. By IRS definition, contributions will not be refunded. In the event a team member cancels from a trip, or raises contributions in excess of project mission expenses, the funds will be used to further evangelistic work in one of many SCORE mission projects. These include support of missionaries on foreign soil, Gospel tracts, youth programs, and other SCORE ministries. All money is donated solely to SCORE International. Financial disbursement is at the discretion of SCORE for mission work worldwide.

In case an individual does not raise enough funds to go or is providentially hindered from going, support is kept in his account for one year to allow him to go at a later date.
