



Child SPONSORSHIP

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is a child sponsor?

- A child sponsor is an individual, a couple, family, Sunday school class, etc., who has decided to personally invest in the life of a child in need. You can build a relational and prayerful connection with your child while helping to financially support his/her well-being.

2. Does my child directly receive the money?

- When you make a sponsorship payment, the money goes to the ministry that your child belongs and is combined with the money of other sponsors. This provides the opportunity for the physical, educational, and spiritual needs of the children. Birthday and Christmas money does go to your child; however, all the kids participate in celebrations, so excess money will help others also.

3. How much of the \$40 goes to administrative support?

- \$6 is kept in a special account for administration costs and for emergency needs at the orphanage, daycare, or school.

4. How long do I sponsor my child?

- Many of the children have experienced little consistency in their lives, so we would love for you to continue sponsorship for as many years as you are able. However, we understand that circumstances arise, and if you can no longer continue please let us know immediately. Also, a child's circumstances could change and they leave the orphanage. Should this happen we would inform you.

5. Can I visit my child?

- You may join one of the many teams SCORE sends to the Dominican Republic, or you can visit your child while in the DR as a tourist. You must contact our home office to arrange a visit with your child.

6. Can I write my child a letter?

- We definitely encourage this! Writing your child letters is a good way to demonstrate that he or she matters. Here are some important tips and suggestions:
 - Keep your letters short and simple
 - Tell about your family – we encourage sending photos of your family
 - Share family activities and what you enjoy doing
 - Share about your relationship with Jesus
 - Share about the area where you live
 - Be an encouragement in any way you can; let your child know you are praying for him/her
 - Do not elaborate on material possessions such as the size of your home or about your car since they live in poverty
 - Do not “open the door” to your child by inviting them to visit you or even asking what kind of gift your child wants. It is also not best to give your email or telephone number
 - Be careful about using slang or colloquialisms that may not translate
 - If the child is being sponsored by a group, it is best that one person be appointed to write the letters

Letters

As a sponsor, you will receive a minimum of two letters a year from your child (Christmas/Easter). Not all children can write, so sometimes they send a picture or card.

We encourage you to write accordingly and send a letter at least twice a year. A SCORE staff member will translate your letter into Spanish.

Packages

Many people ask to send gifts to their sponsored child: however, due to restrictions on how we send letters/packages to the Dominican Republic, please use a 9 1/2" x 14 1/2" Bubble Mailer Envelope. If you send a package bigger than this, please include a donation check to help pay for shipping. We suggest \$12.

Items We Suggest

Small Toys: Include items that children will immediately embrace such as dolls, toy trucks, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, balls

School Supplies: Pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons or markers, writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring books, stickers, composition books, and Spanish children's books.

Hygiene Items: Toothbrush, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, etc

Clothing: Shirts, underwear, socks, ball caps, hair clips, and toy jewelry.

Birthday and Christmas Gifts

To give a birthday or Christmas gift, please go to scoreintl.org then click on the donate button and select sponsor a child. There simply fill out the form and select that it is a birthday or christmas gift. We suggest giving \$25 for birthday/Christmas gifts. You must enter your child's name in the memo and a SCORE staff member in the country will purchase a gift for your child.
