



FAQ's

- **How much is tuition?**

Tuition for the 2021 – '22 CLIMB year is \$12,500. If accepted into the program before April 1st, 2021, there is a \$300 "early bird" discount. Tuition covers the following:

- Room & board
- Instruction for Bible and Language
- Vista language textbook
- Bible study books
- 3 meals a day
- Ground transportation
- (2) in-country excursions
- (2) in-country mission trips
- Laundry (2 loads per week)
- Trip insurance
- CLIMB year t-shirt
- Exit tax

- **What additional costs are there beside tuition?**

Costs that are not covered by tuition are:

- Airfare (\$1,200 for (2) round-trip tickets estimated)
- Doctor visits, hospital stays, and/or medication (\$500 estimated)
- Money for souvenirs, snacks, personal care products, etc. (\$1200 estimated)

- **Can I use an ATM while in the Dominican?**

Yes, ATM's are locally available.

- **Will I have access to WI-FI?**

Internet use will be restricted to specific time slots on authorized days.

- **What kind of food do we eat?**

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are buffet style in the cafeteria at SCORE International's Mission Training Center. The buffet usually includes a hot option, sandwiches, soup, and salad.

- **Do we come home for Christmas?**

Yes.

- **Can family and friends come visit me?**

If family or friends would like to visit, it is recommended that they visit during the "Encounter Week" or "Graduation Week". These times are specifically geared for visitors. SCORE has planned special activities during these weeks.

- **Can I get care packages?**

We have people who travel to the Dominican on a regular basis, and they can hand carry small packages (5 lbs. or less).

- **Where will I stay?**

CLIMB students will be assigned apartment rooms adjacent to SCORE International's Mission Training Center (MTC) that houses short-term mission teams. Each apartment will have twin size beds and a shared bathroom.

- **Will I be covered by health insurance?**

Insurance is provided for every student by Faith Ventures Travel Services. The amount is \$50,000 for emergency, accident, and sickness coverage.
